A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CONTRA COSTA WATER DISTRICT APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CONTRA COSTA WATER DISTRICT LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN CONSISTING OF THE ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL PLAN FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA AS SUPPLEMENTED BY THE CONTRA COSTA WATER DISTRICT ANNEX

WHEREAS, the Bay Area is subject to various earthquake-related hazards such as ground shaking, liquefaction, landsliding, fault surface rupture, and tsunamis; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Area is subject to various weather-related hazards including wildfires, floods, and landslides; and

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa Water District seeks to maintain and enhance both a disaster-resistant District and region by reducing the potential loss of life, property damage, and environmental degradation from natural disasters, while accelerating economic recovery from those disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa Water District is committed to increasing the disaster resistance of its water infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all cities, counties, and special districts to have adopted a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive disaster mitigation funding from Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) has approved and adopted the multi-jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Contra Costa Water District hereby approves and adopts the Contra Costa Water District Local Hazard Mitigation Plan consisting of the multi-jurisdictional Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area as supplemented by the Contra Costa Water District Annex.




