

RESOLUTION NO. 33845-11

ADOPT THE 2010 ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND EBMUD'S ANNEX TO THE PLAN

Introduced by Director McIntosh ; Seconded by Director Foulkes

WHEREAS, the District and the San Francisco Bay Area are subject to various earthquake-related hazards, such as ground shaking, liquefaction, landslides, fault surface rupture, and tsunamis; and

WHEREAS, the District and the Bay Area are subject to various weather-related hazards including wildfires, floods, and landslides; and

WHEREAS, the District recognizes that natural disasters are not confined within city, county, or special district boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the District seeks to maintain and enhance both a disaster-resistant District and region by reducing the potential loss of life, property damage, and environmental degradation from natural disasters, while accelerating economic recovery from those disasters; and

WHEREAS, the District is committed to increasing the disaster resistance of the infrastructure, health, housing, economy, government services, education, environment, and land use systems in the District, as well as in the Bay Area as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (42 U.S.C. sections 5133 et seq.) requires all cities, counties, and special districts to have adopted a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive disaster mitigation funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area has been approved by FEMA and EBMUD's local annex to the Plan has been provided to the Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the East Bay Municipal Utility District hereby adopts the ABAG Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area and EBMUD's local annex to the Plan, as the District's Local Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District commits, and the General Manager and his designees are authorized, to take actions identified as appropriate in the District's Annex to the ABAG Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan.


