RESOLUTION #110518a **ADOPTION OF THE ABAG PLAN "TAMING NATURAL DISASTERS" AS EASTERN CONTRA COSTA TRANSIT AUTHORITY'S LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Bay Area is subject to various earthquake-related hazards such as ground shaking, liquefaction, landsliding, fault surface rupture, and tsunamis; and

WHEREAS, the Bay Area is subject to various weather-related hazards including wildfires, floods, and landslides; and

WHEREAS, Eastern Contra Costa Transit Authority (ECCTA) recognizes that disasters do not recognize city, county, or special district boundaries; and

WHEREAS, ECCTA seeks to maintain and enhance both a disaster-resistant region by reducing the potential loss of life, property damage, and environmental degradation from natural disasters, while accelerating economic recovery from those disasters; and

WHEREAS, ECCTA is committed to increasing the disaster resistance of the infrastructure, health, housing, economy, government services, education, environment, and land use systems in the eastern Contra Costa area as well as in the Bay Area as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all cities, counties, and special districts to adopt a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive disaster mitigation funding from FEMA; and


WHEREAS, ABAG has approved and adopted the ABAG report *Taming Natural Disasters*, created in collaboration with the participating jurisdictions, as the multi-jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:
