

IN THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIVERMORE, CALIFORNIA
A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

The Bay Area is subject to various earthquake-related hazards such as ground shaking, liquefaction, land sliding, fault surface rupture, and tsunamis; and

The Bay Area is subject to various weather-related hazards including wildfires, floods, and landslides; and

The City of Livermore recognizes that disasters do not recognize city, county, or special district boundaries; and

The City of Livermore seeks to maintain and enhance both a disaster-resistant City and region by reducing the potential loss of life, property damage, and environmental degradation from natural disasters, while accelerating economic recovery from those disasters; and

The City of Livermore is committed to increasing the disaster resistance of the infrastructure, health, housing, economy, government services, education, environment, and land use systems in the City, as well as in the Bay Area as a whole; and

The federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Act) requires all cities, counties, and special districts adopt a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive disaster mitigation funding from FEMA; and

The Association of Bay Area Government (ABAG) has approved and adopted the ABAG report *Taming Natural Disasters*, created in collaboration with the participating jurisdictions, as the multi-jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Livermore adopts, and adapts with its local annex, this multi-jurisdictional plan as its Local Hazard Mitigation Plan, a living document.




